The total income for this period was \$6,066.91 and the total expenses were \$8,746.09 for a net loss of \$2,679.18.

Other updates:

Aaron Hawkins, who is a CPA, signed off on our annual financial review and filed our taxes. He did not have any comments or feedback on the financial review. We will need to vote to adopt it tonight.

We have uploaded our compliance documents and they have been approved by VA PTA for our yearly compliance.

Sarah Physioc has agreed to review and sign off on our monthly reconciliations this year. She is reviewing the July reconciliation currently.

The national PTA has approved a dues increase of \$1 per member which will go into effect on July 1, 2025. I would propose we increase our dues to cover the cost of this. I think \$10 for a single membership and \$15 for the family membership would be appropriate. Many schools in the area are already charging these prices for their memberships. We need to give 30 days notice before voting as a general membership to approve an increase.

The insurance has been renewed for the year. It is now good through October 24, 2025.

We need to approve the proposed budget today. It was approved by the executive committee on August 7.
