- B. Treasurer Report
 - 1. Current Balance: \$98,665.64
 - a) October 31 balance: \$100,163.71
 - 2. Recent Highlights
 - a) Since last PTA meeting on October 10:
 - (1) Total income: \$10,390.37
 - (a) Includes interest (\$0.82), donations (\$20), membership dues (\$340), Carnival presale (\$5,480), Carnival Kreepy Kitchen (\$419), Carnival wristbands night of event (\$2,213.75), Carnival business partnerships (\$150.24), and spirit wear (\$1,766.60)
 - (2) Total expenses: \$4,833.54
