- I. Call to order: 1803
  - A. Quorum established
- II. Report of Officers
  - A. President Report
    - Welcome to the first general body meeting! If you're still not a member, you can join at ghpta.com
    - 2. Minutes from general body meeting on May 17, 2022 approved
      - a) Minutes are available on the website
    - 3. Can begin ordering yearbooks now on ghpta.com!
      - a) Also able to submit pictures for the yearbook on the website
    - 4. We are still in search of committee chairs
      - Need chair for Reflections, which is an art program; projects due at the end of October, then move to county level in November; VAPTA will be communicating rules, etc. soon
  - B. Treasurer Report
    - 1. Audit
      - a) Books audited by Aaron Hawkins, CPA and GHES parent; all discrepancies addressed and corrected
      - b) Vote to adopt audit
        - (1) Aye: 27; Nay: 0; Abstain: 0
        - (2) Audit passes; will be filed with financial paperwork
    - 2. Budget
      - a) Please see budget for more details (available on ghpta.com)
      - b) We are unable to issue payments until the budget is approved; have pending payments that will go out as soon as it passes
        - (1) Recent payments were made by prior treasurer for items such as International Week and teacher appreciation items that hadn't been paid out
      - c) Only other outstanding payment is state and national dues
      - d) Budget based on average of last 4-5 years with a few exceptions
      - e) We will be going over budget, which is purposeful, because we have a lot of money in our account; as a non-profit, want to try to come closer to breaking even; have also projected monthly balances and will have a buffer
      - f) Line item notes
        - (1) After school enrichment program: money is collected and then redistributed to teachers involved; not a fundraiser
        - (2) Flying Squirrels game: students get free game ticket for reading a certain number of books; families can then buy discounted tickets at the gate and PTA gets a portion of those profits
        - (3) Fun Run: profit was roughly \$52,000 last year (above our average), but have fewer students this year, so budgeted for less
        - (4) Apps (Kroger, Box Tops, Amazon Smile): easy ways to get donations
          - (a) For Box Tops, take picture of grocery receipts

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- (5) Conferences: approved last school year for travel this school year, so added to the budget; also trying to have teachers participate in a reading program
- (6) Administrative fees: Zoom, Square, etc.
- (7) Accounting fees: expenses for income taxes at the end of the year
- (8) Board materials and supplies: binders, folders, ink, copies; PTA copier currently not working, need to have it fixed
- (9) Reflections: reception for participating students
- (10)Watch D.O.G.S.: breakfast with donuts and coffee in January and supplies for next year
- (11) Ruth Sims Scholarship: two students chosen by school counselors; used for summer school for students who could otherwise not afford to go
- (12)Funding Bulldog take home folders, student agendas, and kindergarten journals
- (13)Barefoot N' Books: salaries to keep library open and gift cards for participants
- (14)Yearbook: Herff Jones holds money and we will not owe if we sell out of yearbooks, which we've historically done
- (15)Carnival: DJ, jugglers, bus drivers, face painters, etc.; \$3,000 for inflatables
- (16) Special Projects: includes BOB, birthday books, popsicles, library luncheon for volunteers, and other projects or supplies
- (17) Centennial: school run, but we will be assisting
- (18)Bulldog PRIDE awards: will supply decorations
- (19)Pansy day: will move to spring and likely change the flower (considering begonias)
- (20)International Night: budget for this year also includes \$250 that wasn't paid from last year
- g) Thank you to our new treasurer, Lisa Hall, for all her hard work on this year's budget!
- h) Vote to pass budget
  - (1) Aye: 27; Nay: 0; Abstain: 0
  - (2) Budget passes

### C. VP Fundraising Report

- 1. Spiritwear
  - a) Using same company as last year; worked well and made a good profit
  - b) Store open early through September 26; will open again in the spring
  - c) Will be shipping to each household, so we won't have to keep items on hand
  - d) Thank you to Brigette for putting this together!
- 2. Fundraisers
  - a) Apps
    - (1) Kroger: link to Kroger card; money goes to PTA at no cost to you
    - (2) Amazon Smile: link to PTA, also no extra charge
    - (3) Box tops: scan receipt and money goes to PTA; no clipping necessary

  - (1) Thank you to Charlotte for taking this on again!
  - (2) Students receive free ticket for reading a certain number of books, then families get discounted tickets at door; a portion of the ticket sales at the door will go towards the PTA
