- B. Treasurer Report
 - 1. Current Balance: \$92,458.50 (as of 10/9/23)
 - a) September 30 balance: \$90,814.31
 - 2. Recent Highlights
 - a) Since last PTA meeting on August 29:
 - (1) Total income: \$3,601.06
 - (a) Includes interest (\$1.57), donations (\$86), membership dues (\$488), carnival presale (\$2,560), yearbook sales (\$40), and business partnerships (\$377.19)

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- (2) Total expenses: \$5,073.30
 - (a) Includes teacher appreciation (\$375.46), credit card fees (\$45.74), accounting expenses (\$350), board materials (\$156.99), Jotform (\$78), insurance (\$377.78), Reflections (\$120.20), national and state dues (\$960.25), education programs (\$1,645.64), carnival supplies (\$165.95), education programs (\$1,645.64), carnival supplies (\$165.95), haunted cemetery (\$58.57), house system expenses (\$42.29), Barc 4 VARC (\$73.80), Bulldog Pride staff shirts (\$200), and international night (\$422.63)
