 - 2. School Safety/Threat Assessments
 - a) There has been an increase in communication related to school safety and threat assessments. This is not new information. There has always been a CCPS threat assessment protocol including school counselors and potentially admin team members to assist.
 - b) When a threat assessment is conducted, depending on the credibility of the threat, we partner with the Chesterfield County Police Department.
 - c) Specific to Grange Hall the threats to others that have been communicated out to the community have been found NOT to be credible, but a poor choice of words and poor choice of communication. Please continue to have conversations at home with your children, remind them what is and is not appropriate for conversations at school and how to handle it.
 - d) If you have any concerns, please reach out to Dr. Jones, Mrs. McCracken or any of the school counselors. We are working to navigate this together. We appreciate the support of our families as we navigate this time in our society. We want to ensure our teaching and learning is progressing safely.
